

Policy Statement on Supply Chain Due Diligence Act

As a responsible company, compliance with the requirements of the german supply chain due diligence act (Lieferkettensorgfaltspflichtengesetz) is a matter of course for CSL. Our products serve to protect and improve the lives and health of people. The protection of human rights and the environment goes hand in hand with this.

Our business activities are based on our globally applicable <u>Statement of Human Rights Principles</u> as well as our <u>Code of Conduct</u>. We set these standards not only for ourselves, but also expect our direct and indirect suppliers to comply with the supply chain due diligence act and are committed to implementation in our supply chain.

Our global risk management system (Third Party Risk Management) meets the requirements of the supply chain due diligence act. We identify, assess and prioritize human rights and environmental risks in our own business area and along our supply chain. Where necessary, we take appropriate preventive and remedial measures. We document these and include them in our annual reporting.
